This concert is organised by the choir association (KCCA), so I hope that if you are not already a member you will join. The annual subscription is a modest £10, and I hope you will enjoy the other benefits of membership as well. In addition to running informal receptions after many of the choir's concerts, the Association organises regular reunions for members. Details may be found on the KCCA website www.kccaonline.org

Performing material will be provided for singers who cannot bring their own. Lunch and dinner are provided free of charge. Tea is available in the Coffee Bar in 'A' Staircase. There is a charge for lunch and dinner for those not singing.

A limited amount of accommodation may be available on a first-come-first-served basis: the charge is between £60 and £65 payable in advance when booking is confirmed. I regret that there is no service of breakfast on Sunday 14 March, but 'brunch' is available from 11.30 am to 1.30 pm.

As last year, this concert is the first in the **Easter at King's Festival**, now in its sixth year. The full list of concerts and services is in the brochure enclosed, and it would be wonderful to see you at some of the later concerts.

All the tickets for the Foundation Concert, and for the rest of Easter at King's are being handled by the Cambridge Corn Exchange Box Office (01223 357851), and not from my office at all. You are able to purchase tickets from the box office, which opens for bookings from 25 January.

Please complete the form and return it to me as soon as you can, **and no later than 12 February**. If you find, having accepted, that you are unable to come, I shall be grateful if you will let me know straightaway.

May I be so bold as to remind you to bring a pencil to the rehearsal?
